Roadway Stabilization project to begin on U.S. 84
Motorists should expect lane closures and minor delays

ESPANOLA – The New Mexico Department of Transportation along with Urettek USA Inc. will begin a roadway stabilization project on Tuesday, April 2, 2024, on U.S. 84/285 in Tesuque.

Work will take place on U.S. 84/285, between mile markers 173 to 176 in both directions. Working hours will be Monday through Saturday, from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. One lane will be closed during working hours. All traffic control devices will be removed at the end of each workday, and all lanes of traffic will be reopened.

This project is expected to take 60 working days and be completed by the summer of 2024.

Drivers are urged to watch out for workers in the area, observe traffic control signs and reduce speed to the posted speed limit. Updates on this project will be posted on the New Mexico Department of Transportation's road advisory website, <http://nmroads.com/>.
