A HEALTHY MIND LETS YOU LEARN, PLAY, AND UNDERSTAND OTHERS. MENTAL HEALTH REFERS TO HAVING EFFECTIVE WAYS TO MANAGE YOUR EMOTIONS AND ENJOY LIFE, EVEN WHEN THINGS ARE CHALLENGING. HAVING A HEALTHY MIND AND BODY ARE BOTH VERY IMPORTANT. EVERYONE HAS GOOD DAYS AND BAD DAYS. A BAD DAY DOESN'T MEAN YOU HAVE A MENTAL ILLNESS, BUT YOU CAN STILL IMPROVE YOUR MENTAL HEALTH.

JUST LIKE PHYSICAL ILLNESS, PEOPLE CAN EXPERIENCE A
MENTAL ILLNESS AT ANY TIME. YOU MAY HEAR PEOPLE
DESCRIBE MENTAL ILLNESS AS A MENTAL DISORDER, A
NEUROLOGICAL DISORDER, OR A MENTAL HEALTH
CHALLENGE. HAVING A MENTAL ILLNESS CAN CHANGE HOW
YOU THINK, FEEL, OR ACT. IT CAN SOMETIMES MAKE IT
HARDER TO DO THE THINGS YOU WANT TO DO. JUST LIKE
WHEN YOUR BODY IS SICK AND YOU GO TO A DOCTOR,
SOMEONE WITH A MENTAL ILLNESS CAN GO TO A MENTAL
HEALTH PROFESSIONAL. PEOPLE DON'T CHOOSE TO HAVE A
MENTAL ILLNESS, BUT THEY CAN CHOOSE TO ADMIT IF
THEY'RE HAVING A HARD TIME. THAT WAY, THEY CAN GET HELP
AND START FEELING BETTER.

Overpayment Scam: Beware of anyone contacting you pretending to be VA

Have you received a call, text or letter from someone pretending to be with the Department of Veterans Affairs alleging you have a substantial VA debt due to overpayment? It can be a scam! The scammer uses

high pressure tactics to insist the debt must be repaid immediately via wire transfer, gift cards, cryptocurrency, or other non-traditional payment methods. VA will never demand Veterans repay their debts in full up front, as VA offers many flexible payment plans at no additional cost. Official VA Debt Management Center (DMC) communication will provide specific details about the debt, offer secure payment through www.pay.va.gov,and your appeal or waiver rights.

If you are suspicious of a communication alleging to be VA, you can verify authenticity with VA at 1-800-827-1000 or contact the DMC at 1-800-827-0648. Never share sensitive information, such as social security numbers, bank account details, or credit card information, when responding to unsolicited requests.

National Take Back Day Saturday, October 25, 2025 10AM to 6PM




